THE ACTIVITY REPORT OF THE LAUNCHING OF DR. PATIENCE SELUMUN TSAVNANDE FOUNDATION (DPTF) HELD ON THE 20TH SEPTEMBER 2020

1.0 PRAYER AND MASS

1.1 The occasion started with a Thanksgiving mass held at St. Peter's Catholic Church Sabon Tasha Kaduna.

1.2 After the thanksgiving mass, the invitees moved to the venue of the launching which was the Mulumba Hall in Queen of Apostles Catholic Church Kakuri, Kaduna.

2.0 LAUNCHING OF THE FOUNDATION

2.1 At about 1.30pm guests were seated and the stage was set for the launching. Mr Philip Omachi, aka Oga Driver anchored the programme. The occasion was chaired by Barr. A.A. Iroagalachi Esq. who is also a member of the Board of Trustees (BOT) of the Foundation.

2.2 Three hundred (300) copies of invitation cards were printed and distributed for the event. It was well attended with over 350 people in attendance. Some of the dignitaries that were in attendance included; His Excellency Senator (Dr) George Akume; Honourable Minister of Special Duties and Inter-Governmental Affairs who was ably represented by the Elder Statesman Simon Uve Shango, members of the Board of Trustees, members of the Advisory Board, Grand Knights of various sub-councils in Kaduna, Traditional Rulers in Kaduna led by the Hakimin Barnawa and Reverend Fathers & Pastors amongst others.

2.3 The programme commenced with the recognition of the dignitaries present with the opening prayer said by V. Rev. Fr. Moses Madaki.

2.4 The Chairman of the occasion, Barr. A.A. Iroagalachi offered the opening remarks. In his speech, he thanked the organizers of the Foundation and welcomed guests to the launching. He highlighted the importance of the Foundation and emphasized the need for all to be part of the noble cause.

2.5 The audience was addressed by Chairman, Board of Trustees (BOT), Sir Thaddeus Tsavnande. In his address, he gave a brief background and explained the reasons why the Foundation was being established.

2.6 He gave an insight into the major activities and methods the Foundation would employ to carry out her activities.

2.7 Finally, the BOT Chairman called on all benefactors, philanthropists, friends and well-wishers to join the Foundation by donating generously to bring succour to the poor.

3.0 LAUNCHING/DONATIONS

3.1 The Minister of Special Duties & Inter-Governmental Affairs through his representative Elder Simon Uve Shango unveiled and launched the Foundation.

3.2 He launched the Foundation on behalf of the Minister with the sum of One Million Naira (N1,000,000.00) only. Elder Uve Shango also on behalf of his family & himself launched with the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Naira (N500,000.00) only.

3.3 Other dignitaries then followed, the Chairman of the occasion Bar. Iroagalachi launched with the sum of One Hundred Thousand Naira (N100,000.00) only, Chief Sabastine Hon SAN, launched with the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Naira (N250,000.00) only. Rev Tiku Nsan and Sir Michael Aule launched with Two Hundred Thousand Naira (N200,000.00) and One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Naira (150,000.00) only respectively. The Chairman Board of Trustees, along with his family who are also members of the BOT, collectively launched the Foundation with the sum of Five Million Naira (N5,000,000.00) only. On the whole, the launching of the Foundation was a huge success. The donations went on as listed here under;

3.5 The total amount realized was Nine Million, Four Hundred and Two Thousand, Eight Hundred Naira (N9,402,800.00) only, made up of Seven Million, Two Hundred Thousand, Eight Hundred Naira (N7,200,800.00) only in cash and Two Million, Two hundred and Two Thousand Naira (N2,202,000.00) only as pledges. 4.0 OTHER ACTIVITIES AT THE LAUNCHING

4.1 Medical

4.1.1 At the venue of the launching, a medical team was on hand to carry out checks on vital signs, free medical consultations and advice as well as administration of some essential drugs. The team comprised of two Medical Doctors and a Nurse. The team was led by Dr Taiwo Hassan Kamorudeen, a Registrar at the Department of Family Medicine Ahmadu Bello University Teaching Hospital, Shika Zaria. The services rendered by the medical team to the participants included temperature checks, blood pressure checks, etc.

4.1.2 The team attended to 45 patients at the event venue, participants were drawn from the various segments of the society. The medical team offered their services free as their contributions. The Foundation provided the drugs and other consumables used at a cost of Twenty-Six Thousand Naira (N26,500.00) only.

4.2 Charity Palliatives

4.2.1 The Foundation provided palliatives to forty (40) indigent persons drawn from various parts of Kaduna town. Each recipient received 3 kg pack of high quality parboiled rice, a litre of vegetable oil and a branded carry bag. Those who benefited cut across all ethnic and religious groups in Nigeria. The presentation of the palliatives was done by various dignitaries that were in

attendance. The total cost of the charity palliatives was One Hundred and Seventy-Eight Thousand Naira (N178,000.00) only.

5.0 GOODWILL MESSAGES AND TESTIMONIES

5.1 Goodwill messages were received from the Hakim Barnawa who spoke eloquently about the Foundation and thanked the organizers for a job well done.

5.2 Testimonies were received from two persons who had benefitted from the kind and philanthropic gestures of late Dr Patience Selumun Tsavnande. These testifiers included Dr. (Mrs) Ima who was a classmate of late Dr Patience Selumun Tsavnande in the medical school. She travelled all the way from Port Harcourt with her husband to attend the event. Also Dr Taiwo Hassan Kamorudeen who was her colleague during their internship at NNPC Medical Centre Kaduna.

6.0 ASSESSMENT

6.1 Looking at the attendance, the program and the funds raised, the launching is hereby adjudged as highly successful.

7.0 CLOSING

7.1 The activities came to a close through the closing prayer after the vote of thanks by Mr Eric Tsavnande, a member of the BOT at 4:30pm.
